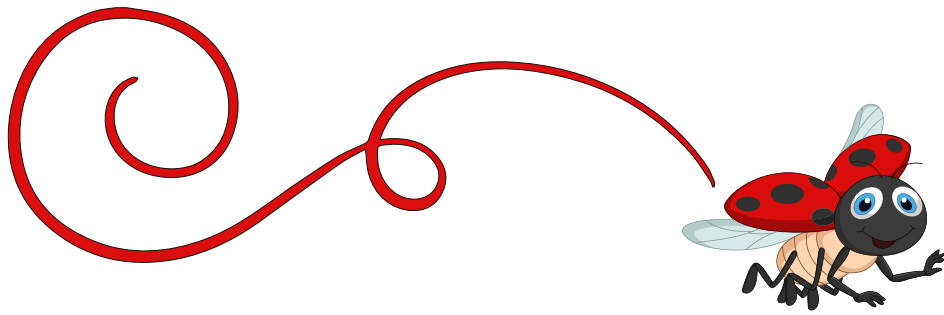

It is a beautiful day.

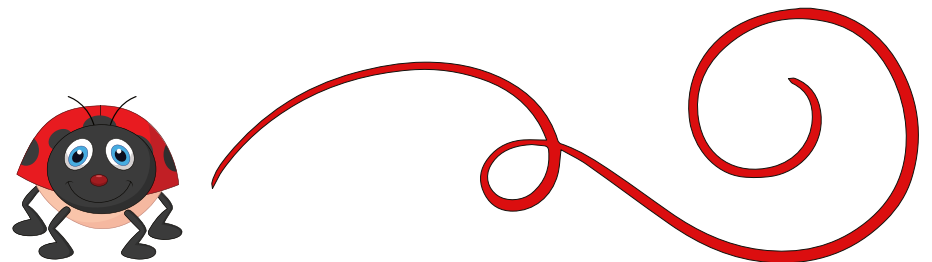
Feodora and Gino have made plans.

Today, they want to have a picnic in the forest.

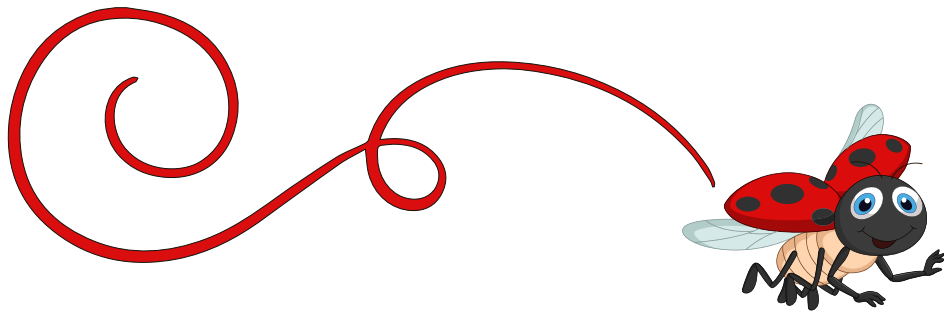
Mama Fino has packed a little meal in Feodora's shoulder bag.

Feodora is already very excited.







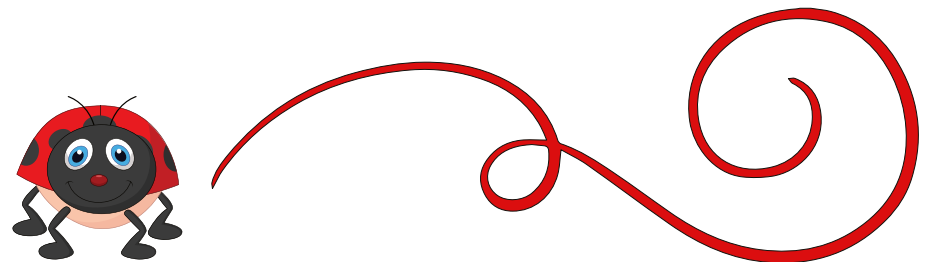
At last, the doorbell rings. Gino is here!

He is also excited about the picnic.

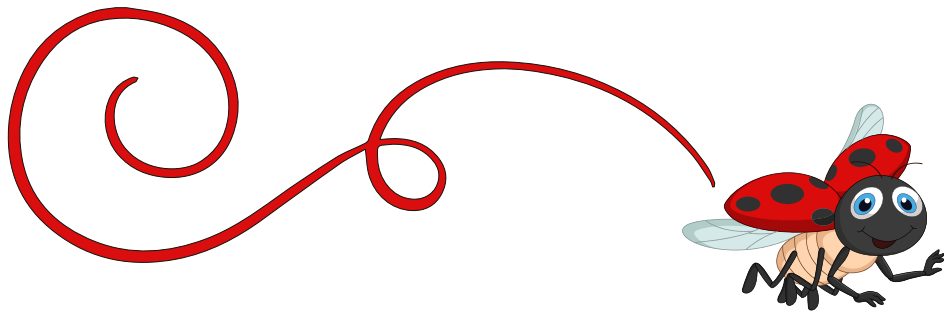
Mama Fino says, "Take good care of each other! And remember:

They walk past Feodora's garden.

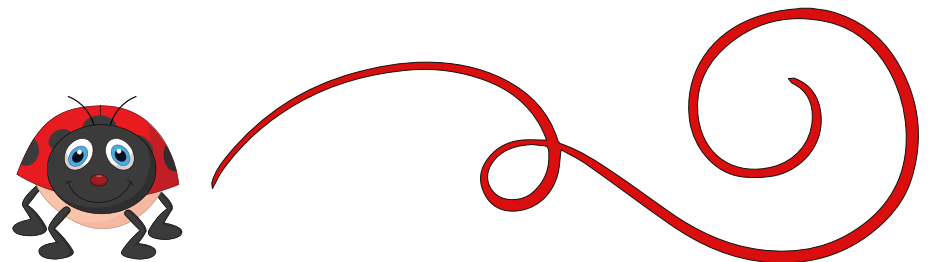
Papa Fino is standing by the fence.

He calls to the children, "Have fun at your picnic. And be home in time for dinner!"

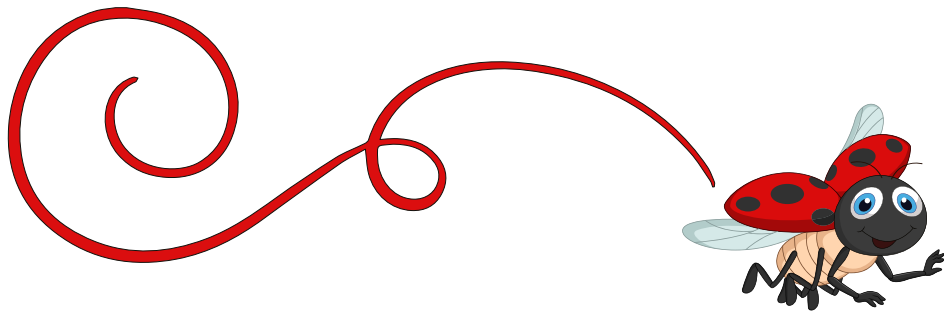
Feodora says, "Yes, Papa. We will."

The children wave to him and walk on.





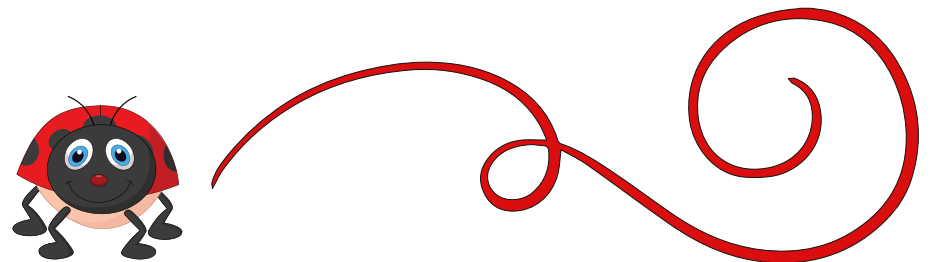


At the forest entrance, there are lots of little creepy-crawlies.

other creatures.

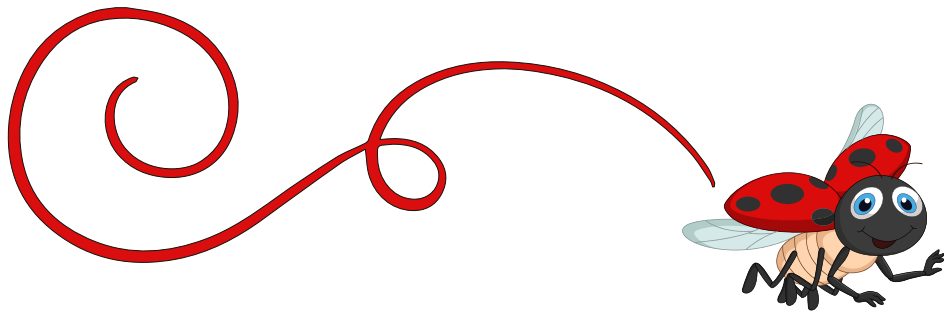
She loves little crawlers.

The two children look for a nice spot.

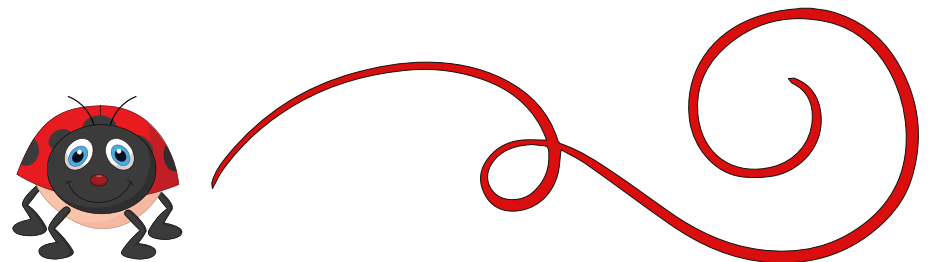
For quite a while, they can't agree.

But then Gino shouts, "Here, Feodora! Let's put our blanket here!"

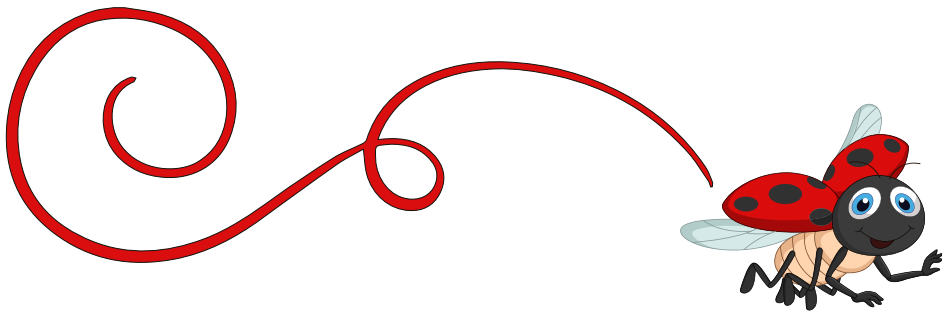
Feodora looks around carefully.

Feodora unpacks the bag.

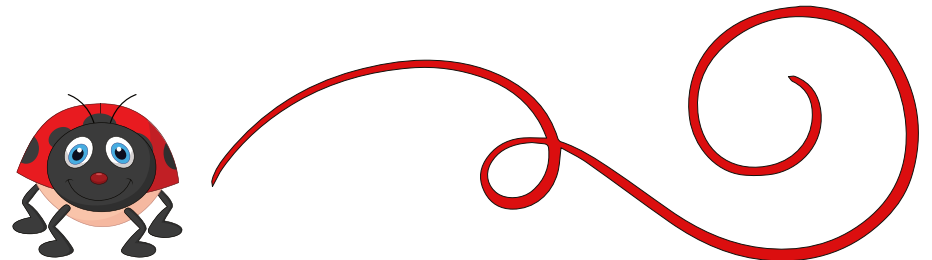
Gino is hungry. He is curious to see what Mama Fino packed.

Feodora takes out grapes, pussy willow twigs and berries.

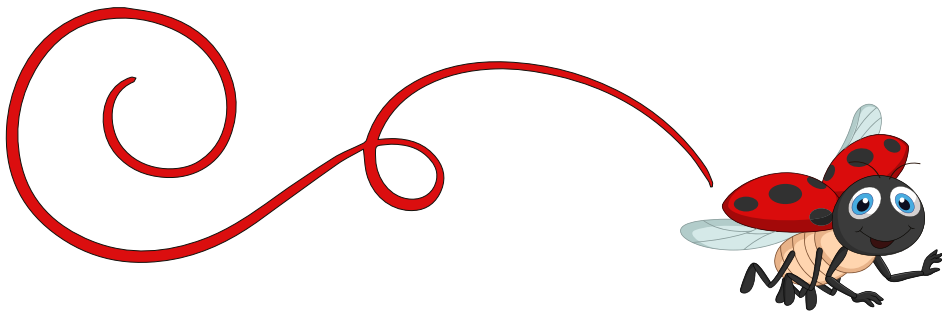
Gino licks his lips.
