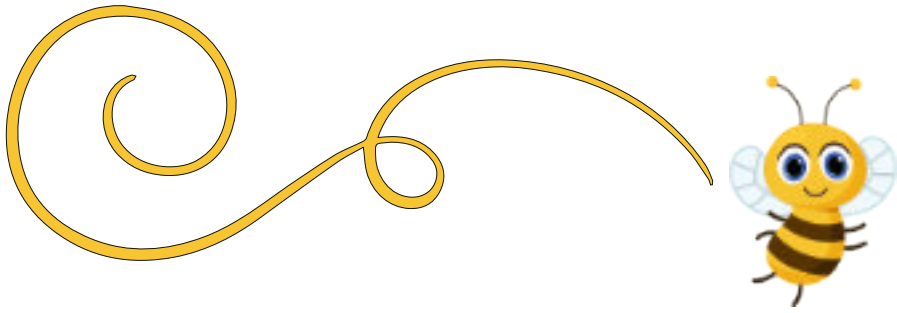

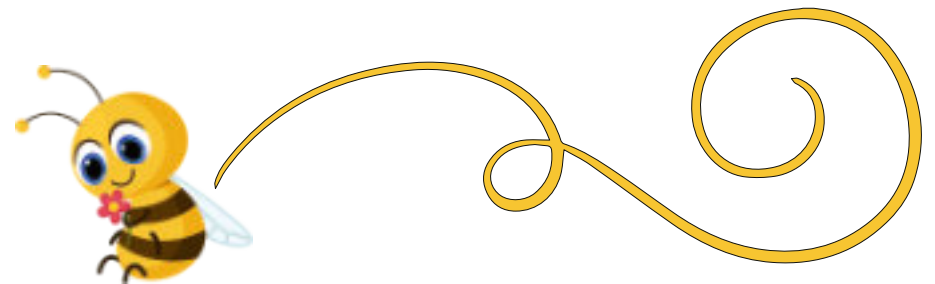

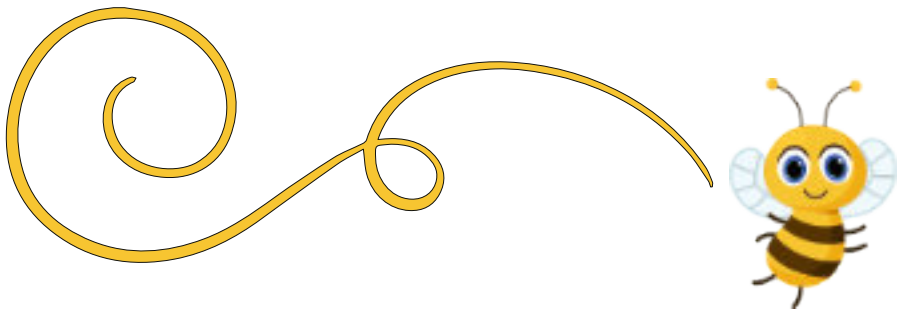




Today, Feodora is going to the market with her mother.

When they arrive at the market square, Feodora wants to go straight to Gino's parents' stand.

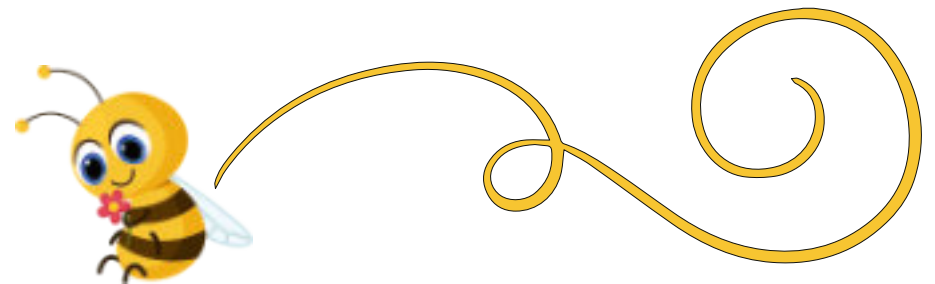
They sell ice cream, coffee, and fresh pastries.

She also feels like having some coffee and pastries.



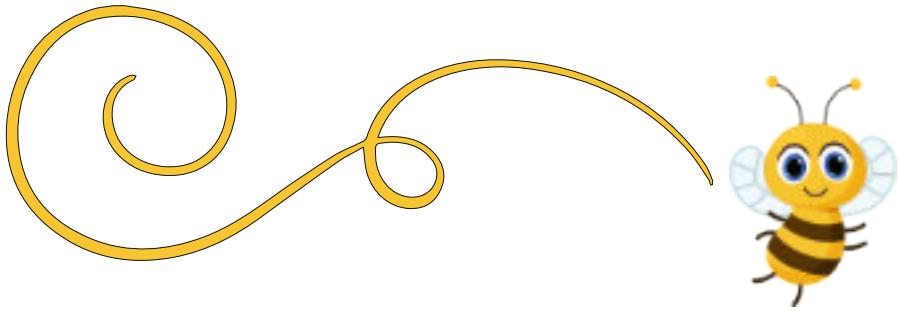

Gino is also happy.

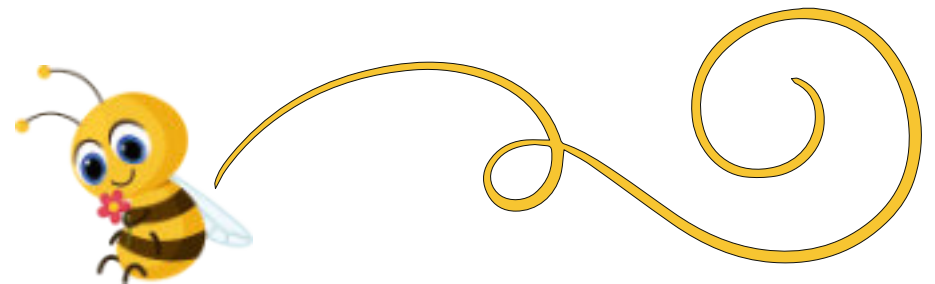
He calls, "Hello, Feodora! Do you want to walk around the market with me?"

Both children get an ice cream.

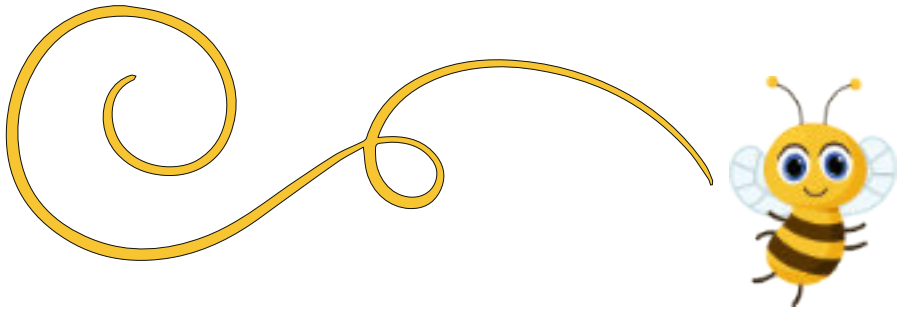
Then they set off.



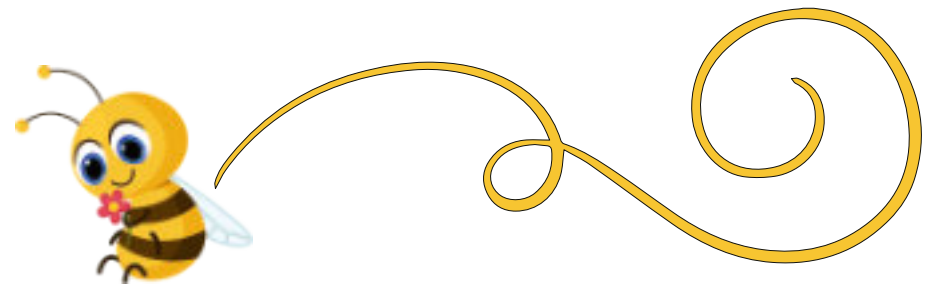

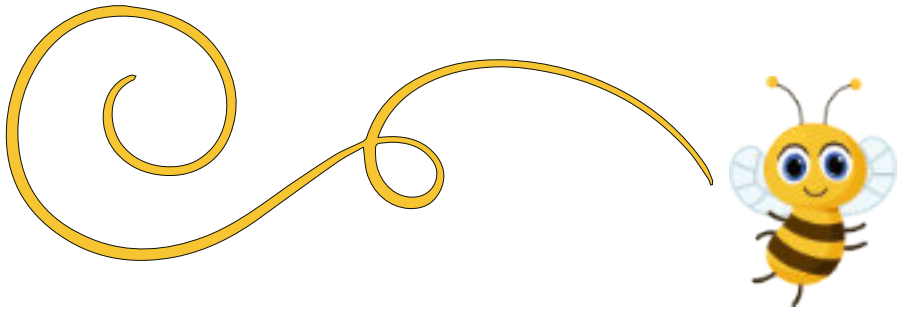

Feodora looks outraged.

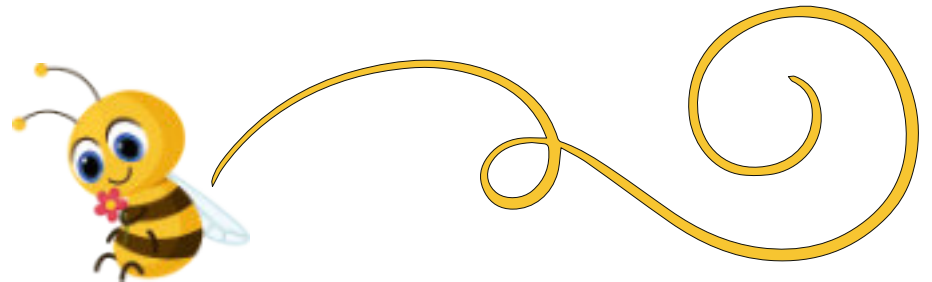
She says to Gino, "She's looking for trouble, isn't she? She looks pretty grumpy!"

Gino nods.

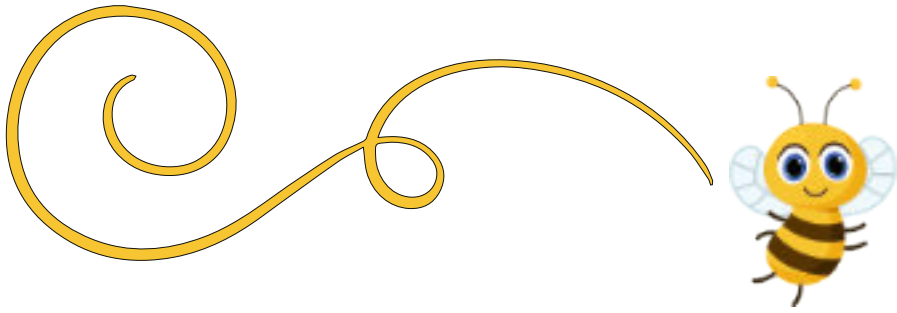
"You're right. She really does look angry."

"Doesn't she belong there?"





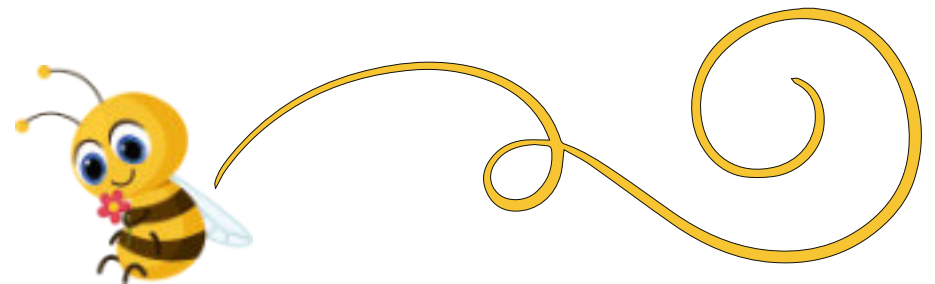


Feodora replies, "That's right! She's probably a bee from the honey seller. Come on, let's take her back to him."

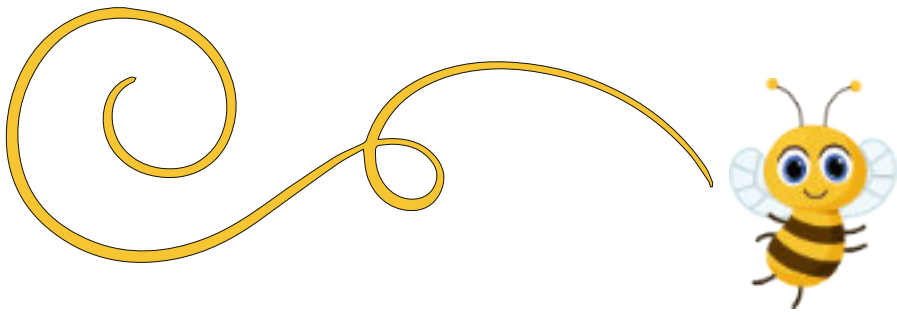
Just as they are about to walk away, the bee flies in the opposite direction.
